

The Council is charged to elect annually a Faculty Secretary. The Executive Committee of the Academic Council wishes to nominate Professor John Staddon for reelection to this position. A brief biography follows:

NOMINEE FOR FACULTY SECRETARY

John E. R. Staddon is a James B. Duke Professor and Professor of Neurobiology and Biology, Emeritus, and his area of research is the psychology and biology of adaptive behavior. Professor Staddon joined Duke in 1967. He has served the Academic Computing Advisory Committee (predecessor to ITAC), Administrative Oversight Committee (predecessor to PACOR), Trustee/Faculty Committee on Honorary Degrees, Academic Priorities Committee, Founders Day Planning Committee, Distinguished Professors Committee, and Harassment Grievance Board. Professor Staddon had a long record of service on the Academic Council prior to his previous elections as Faculty Secretary in 2002 and 2004 and member of ECAC from 2005.
