

BYLAW LANGUAGE CHANGE RE. ANNUAL ACADEMIC COUNCIL ELECTION

OLD LANGUAGE

All nominations and elections to the council shall be by secret ballot among all members of the university faculty defined as eligible to vote in the Bylaws of the University Faculty, Article V. The nominating ballot for each division or school shall list those faculty members eligible to serve on the council according to said Article V of the Bylaws of the University Faculty, on a date early in the spring term, and shall alternate listing them in forward and reverse alphabetical order, year by year. The ballot shall indicate which among these faculty members have already been elected for the coming academic year and who will be on leave or be otherwise unavailable to serve a full term.

NEW LANGUAGE

All nominations and elections to the Council shall be by secret ballot among all members of the university faculty defined as eligible to vote in the Bylaws of the University Faculty, Article V. The nominating ballot for each division or school shall, **at the discretion of the Election Committee**, either list all faculty members who are eligible to serve **or list that subset of eligible faculty members who have expressed a willingness to serve**. The nominating ballot shall be presented to the faculty on a date early in the spring term, and shall alternate listing them in forward and reverse alphabetical order, year by year. **For a ballot that includes all the faculty members that are eligible to serve**, it shall indicate the faculty members who have already been elected for the coming academic year and those who will be on leave, or be otherwise unavailable to serve a full term.
