Dear Provost Kornbluth:

This memo confirms that faculty in the School of Nursing voted to endorse the revised criteria for Appointment, Promotion, and Tenure (APT). The APT criteria were revised based on the recommendation of the Academic Programs Committee to move the statements about the number of publications from the description of the rank to the examples section for each of the Track I, Track II, and Track III criteria.

The revised APT criteria were distributed to faculty for review, discussed at the June Faculty Governance Association meeting, and voted on electronically following that meeting. Sixty-three regular rank faculty members voted, which constitutes a quorum. Of this number, 57 faculty (90.5%) endorsed the revised APT criteria, 4 faculty (6.3%) did not endorse them, and 2 faculty (3.2%) abstained.
