

Charge for a Digital Futures Task Force

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The Digital Futures Task Force will explore issues related to the evolution of and support for new models of digital information use, management, dissemination, and preservation, including research results presented in digital form, online teaching and learning, the digitization of library collections, as well as publishing, data access, and archiving. The group will advise the Provost regarding these issues, develop strategic plans to address them, and oversee their implementation.

Charge to the task force

- To advise the Provost on goals, priorities, principles, and policies related to use, management, access, and preservation of digital information assets produced through the work of the University, and to develop strategic plans to address them.
- To develop and advocate for funding and organizational models to support implementation of these plans, and to ensure that they are designed and supported to persist over time.
- To advocate for and raise awareness of these policies and plans in their own communities and to seek the advice of and inform university governing bodies as appropriate.
- To charge, oversee, and be informed and supported by a set of working groups and implementation teams that will gather information and develop initiatives to meet the strategic plans developed by the task force.

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
